## **GSFAPPS Introduction**

- Primary Means of applying for financial aid
  - Scholarships
  - Grants
  - Service Cancelable Loans
- Replaces multiple paper-based and e-HOPE/ e-TEG applications
  - 24 separate applications/renewal applications
  - Multiple deadline dates



## **GSFAPPS Considerations**

## **Key Considerations**

- Electronic interface
- Security
- Accuracy
- Accelerated processing
- Positive feedback



## **GSFAPPS Features**

## Key Features

- Web-based, with option to print a paper application
- Real-time, on-line edits
- Pre-populate fields where possible
- Ability to suspend application and return



## **GSFAPPS Features** (cont.)

## Key Features (continued)

- Branches to obtain program unique data
- Built-in HELP throughout
- Ability to review application and print
- Provides a list of follow-up documents
- Email confirmations and notifications



## **GSFAPPS** Benefits

- Simplify and standardize
  - Application Forms
  - Submittal dates
- Centralize eligibility checks at GSFC
  - GSFC to create eligibility verification process
  - Schools only certify relative to:
    - Enrollment, course load, GPA, hours, etc.
- Reduced workload on Schools






### **Applicant**

- Next 2 slides illustrate representative input screens (Note the "Help" icon for each field)





- Applicant has three options:
  - Edit
  - Print
  - Submit

# **Application Review**

#### **GSFAPPS**

Page 4 of 4.

CONGRATULATIONS! You have successfully completed filling out your Financial Aid Application. This Screen is your FINAL opportunity to REVIEW the information you have provided PRIOR TO SUBMITTING your Application to the GSFC. At this point you have three options:

- SUBMIT: If you feel that the information displayed on this Review Screen is accurate, then click "SUBMIT." This will forward your Application for further processing by GSFC. You will receive an email acknowledging receipt of your Application at the Commission.
- EDIT: If, upon review, you determine that some information displayed on the Review Screen is NOT accurate, click "EDIT" and GSFAPPS will return you
  to the input Screens. Once you have entered the CORRECT data, you will once again be presented with the Review Screen so you can confirm that
  the information displayed is accurate. At that time, you should click "SUBMIT," and your Application will be forwarded to GSFC for further processing,
- PRINT: GSFC recommends you print a copy of the Application that you submitted for your records. If you are connected to a printer and want to print a copy, click "PRINT."

   Applicant will be instructed what to submit
